

Bookhand is a practical version of the Roman alphabet. As the name states, this is an alphabet which was originally used for handlettering books, and for that reason, it was the model for many of the type face designs in use today. Sometimes called foundational hand because it has been a popular, beginning style of calligraphy, bookhand is an "easy" style which has both elegance and legibility.




